- I request to be put in the rotation of sharing Jerry with other LPC members. I agree that on my assigned "Jerry day", I will ride him and care for him and his tack (as listed on next page) and will be supervised by a responsible adult for the entire time I do so. If I am unable to come on my assigned day, I will switch with another pony club member that is on the list to share Jerry. If I am not able to switch, I will call Riga Meadow the night before my Jerry day and leave a message in the main voicemail box stating that I cannot ride and that he is available for another approved LPC member to ride him. I understand that riding Jerry is a privilege, which can be revoked if I am unable to follow the rules regarding Jerry's care and use.
- I do not want to be assigned a Jerry day at this time. I understand that I can activate this privilege in the future (by contacting the D.C. directly), if desired.
- I can tack up Jerry safely without help.
- I need help tacking up Jerry safely. The person that will help me is _____.

If I ride Jerry on my own, I can

- Ride him in the indoor ring only (no jumping).
- Ride him in the outdoor ring (no jumping).
- Ride him over ground poles.
- Ride him in the fields.
- Jump Jerry in the ring.
- Jump Jerry over field jumps.
- Ride Jerry on a trail ride with approved adult supervision.

Below is a list of items that you must attend to each time you ride.

Before Riding Jerry:

Thoroughly groom Jerry, don't forget his hooves, Pick Back to Front !
Jerry's tack is in the tack room, you may either use the saddle pad on his rack or your own.
Please use a fleece girth cover.

After Riding Jerry:

Please untack him and cool him out properly, hose him off when the weather is warm enough. Use a cooler on him when the weather is cold.
You should walk or graze him until his breathing has returned to normal and his chest is no longer hot.
Don't forget to pick out his hooves!
Please muck out Jerry's stall to clear it of all wet spots and poop piles.
Top off his water bucket so it is completely filled.
Clean Jerry's tack: wash off his bit, and wipe down his saddle and bridle with a damp sponge and saddle soap. Then take a towel, dry it off, and put all the equipment back on his racks.
If the saddle pad and/or girth cover is sweaty, please put them in the laundry room to be washed.
Return all grooming tools to their proper place.
If Jerry was wearing a blanket, put it back on after you ride. If we are having cold weather – please check with the barn manager to see if he will need to wear a blanket.

I Can and will perform the above duties every time I ride Jerry.
